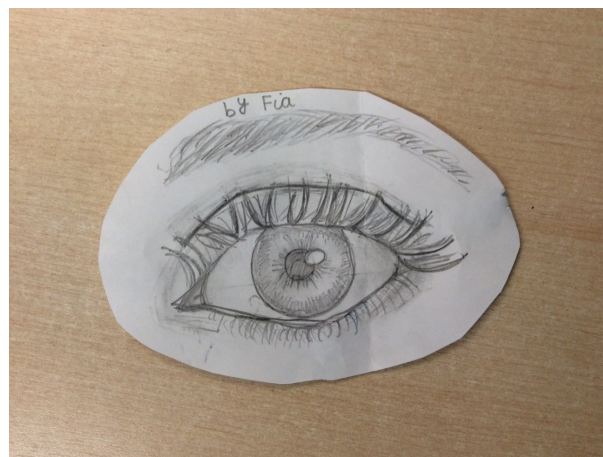

A School Snapshot



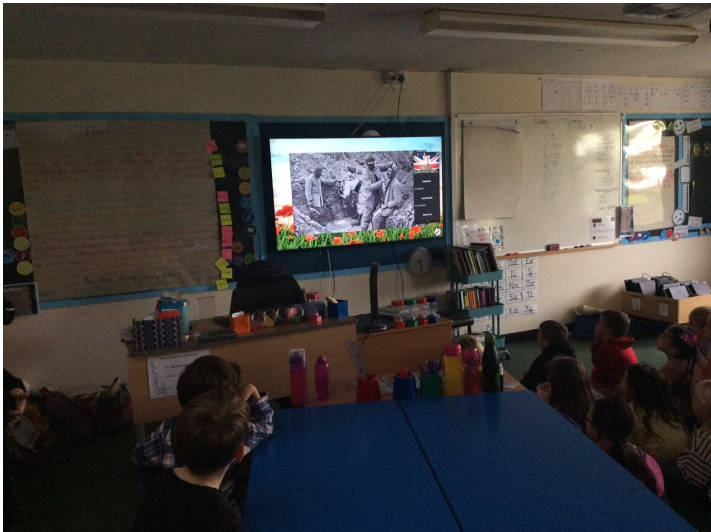

Weekend Winter Warmer

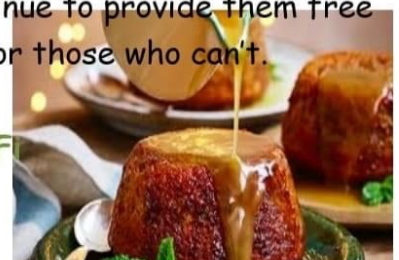


We want to try and help out a bit this winter.
