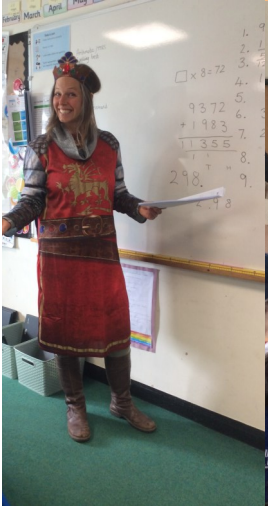
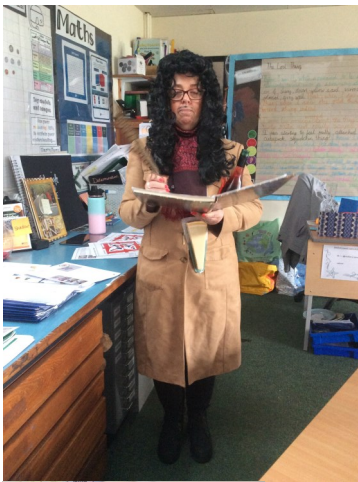
Today has been a very special day for the children. With King Charles III's Coronation this weekend, we have held our own celebrations in school to mark the event.
