Over the summer, we installed the Trim Trail and the KSI playground was resurfaced. We are really excited that next week our KS2 learning spaces will be refurbished. At present, these spaces look tired and worn and in need of some care and attention. We are creating physical learning spaces in the wide corridor, with the far end space being turned into a room to become a calm and nurturing teaching and learning room. We will be laying carpet down throughout the corridor, finishing with a fresh lick of paint throughout.

On top of the internal works, we are also planning for the resurfacing of the Trim Trail space to take place so this can be used all year round and the installation of the basketball posts in the junior playground, possible due to the funds raised by the school community combined with the school yearly capital spend budget. Our aim is to create an environment that is supportive, welcoming and a place that the children are proud to be in and will look after.
