This has now been approved by our Governing Body and has started to be implemented this week. Tina Leack, the Behaviour Lead from TPAT, joined our whole staff meeting to give advice and training on its introduction.

You may remember that Mrs Read shared the news that our new SENDCO, Mrs Joanne Moseley had been appointed. She will be joining the team next week and will be getting to know the school, staff, children and families. We wish her a happy and successful time at the school.

Swimming at Helston Pool starts next Tuesday 10th January for **Year 2** and will run for 10 sessions every Tuesday until Tuesday 21st March. Williams Travel will transport children to and from the pool accompanied by members of our staff. We will be back by the end of the school day and this will not affect school lunch. The cost of the lessons is paid by the school as part of the curriculum but we do rely on contributions towards transport. A contribution of £25 to help cover this cost would be much appreciated and can be paid on ParentPay. If you haven't set up your Parent Pay account please contact the school office. Children will need to bring their swimming kit to school in a named bag to include a hat, goggles, towel and swimming costume – jewellery must not be worn. Can you please complete the Google Form that was emailed out, by Monday 9th January.

Now the children have settled back into routine after the break, a letter outlining this half term's clubs will be going out next week. Clubs will commence the week beginning 16th January.

Well done to the children for a great start to the year.


