

# Key Instant Recall Facts

# Year 5 – Summer Term 2

I can count forwards or backwards in steps of powers of 10 for any given number up to 1,000,000

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.

Children should be able to count forwards and backwards, from any given number, in steps of:

10, 100, 1,000, 10,000 and 100,000

E.g. Count forward in steps of 10,000 from 21,300.

21,300, 31,300, 41,300, 51,300, etc.
