This week, we have had a visit from two Headteachers who work as part of Truro and Penwith Academy Trust. They are part of the continuing school improvement programme and had lots of positive things to say about how we are developing as a school. The school Governors have also had their first formal governor meeting of the school year and are planning monitoring visits to see how our School Development Plan is being put into action.
